### CLINICAL EXPERIENCES

At Chaminade, we believe in the power of learning by doing. As part of an emphasis on hands-on instruction, we ensure Nursing students start clinical coursework in their second year of study.

Our clinical courses cover a range of nursing topics, including medical/surgical nursing, maternal and newborn care, care of children, public health nursing, and psychiatric and mental health care.

While you build on your clinical knowledge across multiple care settings, you'll also gain critical experience working with

diverse patients—all so that you can serve as a strong advocate for high-quality, person-centered care for all members of our community.

### STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES

Chaminade is proud to offer our Nursing students a state-of-the-art simulation facility that complements our experience-focused and forward-looking curriculum. The Dr. and Mrs. Lawrence K.W. Tseu Center for Nursing Education utilizes a variety of educational approaches, including skills labs and standardized patient actors. Students use the E.L. Wiegand Simulation Suite which, incorporates high-fidelity simulation mannequins for a realistic, immersive interface. This approach allows students to engage in clinical reasoning and build confidence as they apply what they've learned.

### EXPERIENCED FACULTY

Our faculty members are research-driven, practice-focused, and passionate about the role of nursing in building healthier communities. When you join the Nursing program family, they become your mentors—preparing you for the challenges and joys you'll encounter in the profession.

### EXAMPLES OF HANDS-ON EXPERIENCES

#### People Who are Houseless

**Simulation:** Students participated in a 10-hour simulation, serving patients whose psychosocial issues, healthcare problems and financial concerns are representative of the larger population of people without houses in Hawai'i. In assisting patients, students developed health assessments, created a comprehensive treatment plan and worked to reduce the stigma of people who are houseless.

**Vaccination Clinic:** Students assisted with COVID mass vaccination clinics, taking on various clinical roles as they checked in patients, reviewed patient healthcare records, gave vaccinations, and conducted patient education and monitoring.

#### Epidemiology Unfolding

**Case Study:** In a simulation to help students understand the process of communicable disease investigation, students were tasked with investigating a mock Hepatitis A outbreak impacting 25 patients—each with a different healthcare history and record. One learning goal was to investigate and identify the source of the disease outbreak.

**Tuberculosis Simulation:** To underscore the importance of screening, testing and precaution protocols, students participated in a "TB clinic" with a variety of patients needing triage and treatment.
